

Guidelines for applying for registration as a Pharmacist

1. A certified copy of the certificate.
2. A transcript of the applicants record to be sent from the school directly to the Council;
3. Must supply proof of character (Referee letter);
4. Police Record;
5. If applicant is registered as a pharmacist in another country, the applicant must show that he or she is not currently under suspension or revocation, has not been convicted of violating any law relating to the practice of pharmacy, or has not had his or her license suspended or revoked;
6. A medical certificate;
7. Two passport size photos (as specified on the application form);
8. A copy of one official form of identification for e.g. identification card or driver's license.
9. You may pay your fees (non-refundable) of **\$ E.C. 275.00 (\$US 105.00)** to **Pharmacy Council**, using any one of the methods below:
 - Draft drawn on a St. Lucian bank.
 - Personal cheque from a St. Lucian Bank.
 - International Money Order.
10. First time registrants must attend an interview with the Pharmacy Council in St. Lucia and should familiarize themselves with the Pharmacy Act No. 8 of 2003 and the Pharmacy Regulations No. 138 of 2007 available at the website www.pharmacycouncilslu.org.
