Guidelines for Pharmacist Internship

- 1. The pharmacy internship programme is for persons who are nationals of St. Lucia and have no previous pharmacy practical experience.
- 2. Persons must inform the Council via email of their interest in registering as a pharmacist at least one (1) year before completion of their pharmacy programme.
- 3. On completion of the pharmacy programme the following documents must be sent to the Council:
 - a. Transcript (Sent directly from the school to us).
 - b. Completion letter from the school.
- 4. The internship period consists of six (6) months. This includes a three (3) month rotation at a hospital and a three (3) month rotation at a community pharmacy.
- 5. The pharmacist will be evaluated at the end of each period.
- 6. The Pharmacist Internship Evaluating Form must be sent to the Council at the end of each period.
- 7. The documents below are available on the website.
 - a. Pharmacist Internship Manual.
 - b. Pharmacist Internship Evaluating Form.
 - c. Pharmacist Feedback on Internship Programme Form.
- 8. On successful completion of the pharmacy internship programme the pharmacist must apply to be registered as a pharmacist.
